

2015 Iowa General Assembly Wireless Network Internet Access Agreement

Payment Terms

The cost is **\$200** for an annual calendar year subscription. Please note free public wireless will be available in the Capitol. The main benefit of a subscription will be limited support from the Legislative Help Desk.

Once the agreement for service has been accepted in writing, payment for the service shall be due. Payment must be by check. The **check** must be made **payable to the Legislative Services Agency**. Term of Agreement and Period of Service

The terms of this agreement and the period of service under this agreement are from January 1, 2015 to December 31, 2015.

Acceptable and Unacceptable Uses

The following activities are acceptable under this agreement:

- Using the Services of the General Assembly's wireless network to access the Internet. Most forms of Internet transport are supported. Http, ftp, POP mail, and SSL traffic are all supported. Some remote access products and VPN services will not function through our firewall. Any protocol trying to establish an inbound connection to our network will fail.

The following activities are prohibited:

- Using the Services to transmit any material (by email, uploading, posting, or otherwise) that, intentionally or unintentionally, violates any applicable local, state, national or international law.
- Using the Services to transmit any material (by email, uploading, posting, or otherwise) that infringes any copyright, trademark, patent, trade secret, or other proprietary rights of any third party.
- Using the Services to threaten the integrity and/or security of any network or computer system (including, but not limited to, transmission of worms, viruses or other malicious codes and accessing any device or data without proper authorization).
- Using the Services to access, or to attempt to access, the accounts of others, or to penetrate, or attempt to penetrate, security measures of or another entity's computer software or hardware.
- Attempting to use the Services in such a manner so as to avoid incurring charges for or otherwise being required to pay for such usage.
- Violating generally accepted standards of Internet or other networks' conduct and usage, including, but not limited to, denial of service attacks, web page defacement, port and network scanning, and unauthorized system penetrations.
