## A BILL

FOR AN ACT PROHIBITING ANY PERSON FROM HOLDING MORE THAN TWO CONSECUTIVE TERMS OF CERTAIN COUNTY AND SCHOOL DISTRICT OFFICES; AMENDATORY TO CHAPTER 1, TITLE V, CODE 1873.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa,* That chapter 1, title V, Code 1873, shall be amended by adding thereto immediately after section 593 the following new section:

SEC. 2. Sec. 593 $\frac{1}{2}$ . No person shall be eligible to hold more than two consecutive terms of any one of the following offices: County treasurer, county auditor, county clerk of the courts, sheriff or district school treasurer.

SEC. 3. This act being deemed of immediate importance shall take effect immediately after its publication in the *Iowa State Register* and *Iowa State Leader*, newspapers published at Des Moines, Iowa.
