A BILL

FOR AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 1457 OF THE CODE OF 1873, ON THE ADOPTION
OF "THE HERD LAW."

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa,* That section
2 1457 of the Code of 1873 be amended and construed so that sections fourteen hundred and
3 fifty to fourteen hundred and fifty-six, inclusive, of chapter 3, title XI of the Code, shall be in
4 full force in such county after the expiration of ninety days after said election, and shall
5 remain in force from year to year, if it shall have been decided by a majority to restrain
6 stock from running at large, without being submitted by the board of supervisors in June of
7 each year thereafter.

SEC. 2. All acts or parts of acts inconsistent with this amendment are hereby repealed.

SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE FILE NO. 65.]

A BILL

FOR AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 5, CHAPTER 70, OF THE ACTS OF THE FIFTEENTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY, RELATING TO THE ADOPTION OF THE HERD LAW.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa*, That section five (5),
2 of chapter seventy (70), of the acts of the fifteenth general assembly, be amended by strik-
3 ing out all of said section after the word "act," in the seventeenth line thereof.

SEC. 2. This act being deemed of immediate importance, shall take effect and be in force
2 from and after its publication in the *Iowa State Register* and *State Leader*, newspapers pub-
3 lished in Des Moines, Iowa.
