## A BILL

FOR AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 3764 OF THE CODE, RELATIVE TO COMPENSATION  
OF STATE PRINTER.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa,* That the following be  
2 added to section 3764 of the Code of 1873: "*Provided,* that nothing contained in this section  
3 shall be construed as fixing the rate of compensation for printing letter-heads, envelopes or  
4 postal cards, and it shall be the duty of the secretary of state to have such work done by con-  
5 tract with the office agreeing to do the same for the lowest price.

SEC. 2. This act being deemed of immediate importance, shall take effect and be in force  
2 from and after its publication in the *State Register* and *State Leader*, newspapers published in  
3 Des Moines, Iowa.

## A BILL

FOR AN ACT TO AMEND SECTIONS 3755, 3756, 3757, 3758, 3760 AND 3763, CHAPTER 1, TITLE XXIII OF THE CODE, IN RELATION TO COMPENSATION OF CERTAIN PUBLIC OFFICERS.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa.* That section 3755  
2 be amended by striking out of the first and second lines "three thousand dollars" and insert-  
3 ing in lieu thereof "twenty-seven hundred dollars."

SEC. 2. That section 3756 be amended by striking out of the first and second lines  
2 "twenty-two hundred dollars" and inserting in lieu thereof "two thousand dollars"; also, by  
3 striking out of the third line "twelve hundred dollars" and inserting in lieu thereof "one  
4 thousand dollars."

SEC. 3. That section 3757 be amended by striking out of the first and second lines  
2 "twenty-two hundred dollars" and inserting in lieu thereof "two thousand dollars"; also, by  
3 striking out of the third line "twelve hundred dollars" and inserting in lieu thereof "one  
4 thousand dollars."

SEC. 4. That section 3758 be amended by striking out of the first and second lines  
2 "twenty-two hundred dollars" and inserting in lieu thereof "two thousand dollars": also, by  
3 striking out of the third line "twelve hundred dollars" and inserting in lieu thereof "one  
4 thousand dollars."

SEC. 5. That section 3760 be amended by striking out of the second line “twenty-two  
2 hundred dollars” and inserting in lieu thereof “two thousand dollars”; also, by striking out  
3 of the third and fourth lines “twelve hundred dollars” and inserting in lieu thereof “one  
4 thousand dollars.”

SEC. 6. That section 3763 be amended by striking out of the second line “fifty dollars”  
2 and inserting in lieu thereof “twenty-five dollars.”

SEC. 7. That all acts inconsistent with this act are hereby repealed.
