A BILL

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

2 Sec. 591. That a township clerk, one assessor, and one highway supervisor for each high-
3 way district in each civil township in this state, shall be chosen by the qualified voters of
4 each township at the next general election, and shall hold their offices for the term of two
5 years.
