A BILL

FOR AN ACT TO AMEND CHAPTER 28, OF THE PUBLIC ACTS OF THE FIFTEENTH
GENERAL ASSEMBLY, IN RELATION TO THE ASSESSMENT OF TAXES.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa,* That section 1,
2 chapter 28, of the public acts of the fifteenth general assembly, be amended by adding thereto
3 the following: "except to counties having an area exceeding nine hundred square miles, and
4 to such counties the provisions hereof shall apply."

SEC. 2. This act, being deemed of immediate importance, shall take effect and be in force
2 from and after publication in the *Iowa State Register* and the *Council Bluffs Nonpareil*, news-
3 papers published in Des Moines and Council Bluffs, Iowa.
