A BILL

FOR AN ACT AMENDATORY TO SECTION 2, CHAPTER 123, OF THE ACTS OF THE SIXTEENTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY, RELATING TO TOWNSHIPS, AND INCORPORATED TOWNS AND CITIES, TO AID IN THE CONSTRUCTION OF RAILROADS.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa,* That section 2, chapter 123, of the acts of the sixteenth general assembly, be and the same is hereby amended by striking out the words “least twenty,” in the eleventh line of said section, and inserting in lieu thereof the words “not less than five, nor more than twenty.”

SEC. 2. This act, being deemed of immediate importance, shall take effect and be enforced after its publication in the *Daily State Register* and *Iowa State Leader*, newspapers published at Des Moines, Iowa.

J. H. KING, from the committee on railroads, submitted the following report:
