A BILL

FOR AN ACT TO AMEND SECTIONS 2, 3, 5, 6 AND 9, OF CHAPTER 100, OF THE
LAWS OF THE SIXTEENTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa,* That the words
2 "or board for men and teams" be inserted in section 2, immediately after the word "ma-
3 terial" in the third line. Also in section 3, immediately after the word "fixtures" in the
4 second and eleventh lines. Also in section 5, immediately after the word "material" in the
5 first line, and in section 6, immediately after the word "material" in the seventh and
6 twelfth lines. Also in section 9, immediately after the word "material" in the eighth, the
7 twenty-eighth and forty-second lines.

SEC. 2. This act, being deemed of immediate importance, shall take effect and be in force
2 from and after its publication in the *Iowa State Register* and *State Journal*, newspapers pub-
3 lished at Des Moines, Iowa.
