A BILL

FOR AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR THE PAYMENT OF THE EXPENSES OF DEFENDING
ACTIONS RELATING TO THE TITLE OF THE STATE SCHOOL LANDS.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa,* That there be
2 and is hereby appropriated, out of any money in the state treasury not otherwise appropriated,
3 the sum of seven hundred and eleven dollars and twenty-five cents, to pay expenses incurred under
4 chapter 29 of the private, local; and temporary laws of the fifteenth general assembly.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the *Iowa*
2 *State Register* and *Iowa State Leader*, newspapers published at Des Moines.
