A BILL

FOR AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO PURCHASE LANDS, AND TO ERECT AND FURNISH BUILDINGS, FOR THE SOLDIERS' ORPHANS' HOME AND HOME FOR INDIGENT CHILDREN.

WHEREAS, The state has not heretofore made any appropriation for buildings for the soldiers' orphans' home and home for indigent children, and the institution having occupied the temporary quarters built about seventeen years ago for troops until the same, by reason of natural decay, are no longer fit for such use; and the proper administration of the home requiring more land for farm purposes, therefore,

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa,* That there is hereby appropriated the following sums for the purposes designated:

SEC. 2.	For eight new cottages	-	-	\$16,000
SEC. 3.	For the erection of one school building	-	-	4,000
SEC. 4.	For general repairs			1,500
SEC. 5.	For the introduction and maintenance of mechanical and other industrial occupations for the instruction of the inmates	-	-	1,300
SEC. 6.	For furniture	-	-	3,000
SEC. 7.	For library	-	-	200

SEC. 8. The said sums to be applied upon the purposes designated, to be drawn by the
2 trustees of the said home by proper order upon the auditor of state; in the case of building
3 and furnishing new buildings, said order to be accompanied by vouchers verifying the ex-
4 penditure under such head.

SEC. 9. All contracts made for the buildings contemplated by this act shall be awarded
2 upon bids advertised for during at least one month before such award is made, in not less
3 than three newspapers published in this state.

SEC. 10. This act to take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the *Iowa*
2 *State Register* and *Iowa State Leader*, newspapers published in Des Moines, Iowa.
