A BILL

FOR AN ACT TO AMEND SECTIONS 6 AND 8, OF CHAPTER 77, OF THE SEVENTEENTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY, IN RELATION TO THE COMPENSATION OF RAILROAD COMMISSIONERS AND THEIR CLERK.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa,* That section 6, of
2 chapter 77, of the laws of the seventeenth general assembly, be and the same is hereby
3 amended as follows: Strike out the words "three thousand," in the third line of said sec-
4 tion, and insert "two thousand." Strike out the words "fifteen hundred," in the seventh
5 line, and insert the words "twelve hundred."

SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE FILE NO. 348.]

A BILL

FOR AN ACT TO AMEND SECTIONS 6 AND 8, OF CHAPTER 77, OF THE LAWS OF THE SEVENTEENTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY, IN RELATION TO THE COMPENSATION OF THE RAILROAD COMMISSIONERS AND THEIR SECRETARY; AND PROVIDE FOR THE MANNER OF COLLECTING THE SPECIAL FUND FOR THE SAME.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa,* That section 6 be amended as follows: Strike out of the third line the words "three thousand," and insert in lieu thereof the words "twenty-five hundred." Also, strike out in the seventh line the words "fifteen hundred," and insert in lieu thereof "twelve hundred."

SEC. 2. That section 8 be amended as follows: Strike out all after the word "state," in the sixth line, and add in lieu thereof the following: "The taxes levied as provided by this chapter shall become due and payable at the state treasury on the first day of February following the levy thereof, and if said taxes are not paid as herein provided, it shall be the duty of the treasurer of state to collect the same by distress and sale of any property belonging to such company in the state, in the same manner as required of county treasurers in like cases, by section 858 of the Code, and the record of the state board in such case shall be sufficient warrant therefor.
