SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE FILE NO. 449.

A BILL

FOR AN ACT MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE ADDITIONAL PENITENTIARY AT ANAMOSA.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa,* That there be
2 and hereby is appropriated out of any moneys in the state treasury not otherwise appro-
3 priated, or so much thereof as may be necessary for the several objects hereinafter named,
4 to-wit:

5	For extension of railroad track on prison grounds	-	-	\$ 1,800
6	For the completion of the south cell-house, and for the erection of a chimney-			
7	stack - - - - -	-	-	10,000
8	For constructing sewer	-	-	5,000
9	For slate roof on engine-house	-	-	460
10	For steam heating apparatus for new cell-house	-	-	5,500
11	For material for constructing five new hand-cars	-	-	100
12	For transportation of discharged convicts	-	-	1,000
13	For rewards offered for escaped prisoners	-	-	500
14	For furnishing warden's house	-	-	250
15	For work on wall	-	-	15,000

SEC. 2. The money hereby appropriated shall be expended under the direction of the
2 warden, and in accordance with plans submitted to, and approved by, the executive council:
3 *provided*, that after the work on any of the specified items is completed, any remaining bal-
4 ance of money unexpended on such items may be applied to work on the wall.

SEC. 3. This act, being deemed of immediate importance, shall take effect and be in force
2 after its publication in the *Iowa State Register* and *Iowa State Journal*, newspapers pub-
3 lished in Des Moines, Iowa.
