Your Committee on Schools, to whom was referred house file No. 528, a bill for an act providing for the publication and distribution of the school laws, beg leave to report that they have had the same under consideration, and have instructed me to report the same back to the house with the recommendation that it be amended by inserting after the word "freight," in the second section, the following: "and the county superintendents shall turn over the proceeds to the county auditor, who shall make returns of the same as provided by law"; also, that the word "cloth," in the first section, shall be stricken out, and the word "paper-board" inserted in lieu thereof; and when so amended, that it do pass.

A BILL

FOR AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE PUBLICATION AND DISTRIBUTION OF SCHOOL LAWS.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa,* That the superintendent of public instruction shall, immediately after the adjournment of the eighteenth general assembly, cause to be published and bound in cloth a sufficient number of school laws, with such decisions, rulings, notes and forms as he may deem desirable to aid school officers in the discharge of their duties, to furnish one copy to the secretary of each school board, and to every county superintendent. He shall make appropriate references to show when and where former laws were amended, and indicate the effect of such changes and amendments.

SEC. 2. He shall also cause to be published, in paper covers, a sufficient number for the use of sub-directors, directors of independent districts, teachers, and other parties desiring copies of school laws. This edition shall contain all the general school law, with notes and forms, but not the decisions. It shall be distributed to county superintendents under the

5 direction of the secretary and auditor of state, who shall fix the price, which shall cover the
6 cost, including freight. Each member of the board of directors shall be furnished with a
7 copy of the school laws in paper cover, without expense, and all officers receiving any copies
8 of school laws shall turn them over to their successors in office.

SEC. 3. This act being deemed of immediate importance, shall take effect and be in force
2 from and after its publication in the *Iowa State Register* and *Iowa State Leader*, newspapers
3 published in Des Moines, Iowa.
