Your committee on schools, to whom was referred substitute for senate file No. 7, a bill for an act to amend sections 1719 and 1808 of the Code of Iowa of 1873, in relation to a tie vote of the electors at the election of school directors, beg leave to report that they have had the same under consideration and have instructed me to report the same back to the house with the recommendation that it be amended by inserting the following after the word "secretary," in the third line of section 1: "shall notify the secretary of the district township board of such tie, and," and when the amendment is adopted it do pass.

SUBSTITUTE FOR SENATE FILE NO. 7.]

A BILL

Com. on Schools

FOR AN ACT TO AMEND SECTIONS 1719 AND 1808 OF THE CODE OF 1873, IN RELATION TO A TIE VOTE OF THE ELECTORS AT AN ELECTION OF SCHOOL DIRECTORS.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa,* That section 1719 of
2 the Code of 1873 be and the same is hereby amended by adding to said section the following:
3 "When there is a tie vote between two persons for the office of sub-director, the secretary
4 shall notify said persons to appear at the regular meeting of the board on the third Monday
5 in March to determine the tie vote by lot before one or more members of the board elected,
6 and the certificate of election shall be given accordingly. Should either party fail to appear
7 or take part in the lot, the secretary shall draw for him."

SEC. 2. That section 1808 be and the same is hereby amended by annexing to the said
2 section the following: "In cases of a tie vote in the election of director or directors, the sec-
3 retary shall notify them to appear at the regular meeting of the board on the third Monday
4 in March to determine their election by lot before one or more members of the board elected,

5 and the certificate of election shall be given accordingly. Should either party fail to appear
6 or take part in the lot, the secretary shall draw for him.”

SEC. 3. This act being deemed of immediate importance, shall take effect and be in force
2 from and after its publication in the *Iowa State Register* and *Iowa State Leader*, newspapers
3 published in Des Moines.
