

A BILL

FOR AN ACT RELATING TO SALES, AND SOLICITING ORDERS FOR SALES, OF INTOXICATING LIQUORS IN CERTAIN CASES, AND PROVIDING PUNISHMENT THEREFOR.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa,* It is hereby made
2 unlawful for any person, persons, company or corporation, having, under the laws of this
3 state, a permit for the sale of intoxicating liquors for mechanical, medicinal, sacramental or
4 culinary purposes, to sell intoxicating liquors directly or indirectly, or to solicit, take or accept
5 any orders for the sale thereof, either by himself, his clerk, servant, agent or employee, out-
6 side of the county in which said permit is issued.

SEC. 2. The soliciting, taking or accepting any order for the purchase or sale of intoxi-
2 cating liquor, where said order, if filled, is to be filled in, or said liquor, if forwarded, is to
3 be forwarded from, another county than that in which said order is solicited, taken or ac-
4 cepted, is hereby made and declared to be a sale of intoxicating liquors within the meaning
5 of the statutes of this state relating to the sale of intoxicating liquors; and such soliciting,
6 taking or accepting of any order as aforesaid, is hereby made and declared to be unlawful.

SEC. 3. If any person, by himself, his clerk, servant, agent or employee, shall, for himself,
2 or any person else, directly or indirectly, or on any pretense, or by any devise, sell any intoxi-
3 cating liquor, or solicit, take or accept any order for the sale thereof in violation of any of
4 the provisions of this act, he shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and the county in
5 which such sale as aforesaid is made, or said order is solicited, taken or accepted, is hereby
6 given jurisdiction of offenses under this act. And informations, indictments, proceedings,
7 trial and judgment for the violation of any of the provisions of this act, shall be had, pro-
8 ceeded with and enforced in accordance with the provisions of section 1540 of the Code; and
9 upon the first, second, third, and subsequent convictions respectively hereunder, the person so
10 convicted shall be punished by fine, and committed until paid, or by imprisonment to the
11 same extent, and by the same punishment, that is now provided in said section 1540 for first,
12 second, third, and subsequent convictions thereunder.

SEC. 4. Courts and jurors shall construe this act so as to prevent evasion, and so as to
2 cover all sales or orders, as aforesaid, whether the consideration therefor be money, property,
3 labor, services rendered or to be rendered, or other valuable thing. But it is expressly pro-
4 vided that the provisions of this act shall not apply to purchases by, or sales to, persons hold-
5 ing permits under the laws of this state, when the same are made in accordance with said
6 permits.

SEC. 6. This act, being deemed of immediate importance, shall take effect from and
2 after its publication in the *Iowa State Register* and *Iowa State Journal*, newspapers published
3 at Des Moines, Iowa.
