

A BILL

FOR AN ACT MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE IMPROVEMENT OF THE PENITENTIARY AT FORT MADISON.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa,* That there be
2 and is hereby appropriated out of any money in the treasury not otherwise appropriated, or
3 so much thereof as may be necessary for the several objects hereinafter named, to-wit:

4 For the purpose of raising wall of the cell house, the sum of six thousand five hundred
5 dollars (\$6,500).

6 For the purpose of providing an iron or fire-proof roof over the cell house, the sum of nine
7 thousand five hundred dollars (\$9,500).

8 For the purpose of erecting a wash house, the sum of four thousand dollars (\$4,000).

9 For the purpose of erecting a blacksmith shop, the sum of two thousand five hundred
10 dollars (\$2,500).

11 For the purpose of building an addition to the clerk's office, the sum of three hundred
12 dollars (\$300).

13 For the purpose of general repairs, the sum of three thousand dollars (\$3,000).

14 For the purpose of the transportation of discharged convicts, the sum of two thousand
15 dollars (\$2,000.)

16 For the purchase of new furniture, carpets, etc., for warden's house, the sum of five hun-
17 dred dollars (\$500).

18 For the purchase of cook-range and tank, the sum of four hundred and fifty dollars (\$450).

19 For the purpose of steam heating for the penitentiary, the sum of six thousand dol-
20 lars (\$6,000).

SEC. 2. The money hereby appropriated for the improvement of said penitentiary shall
2 be expended under the direction of the warden, and in accordance with plans submitted to,
3 and approved by, the executive council.

SEC. 3. This act, being deemed of immediate importance, shall take effect and be in force
2 from and after its publication in the *Iowa State Register* and *Iowa State Journal*, newspapers
3 published in Des Moines, Iowa.

For the purpose of general repairs, the sum of three thousand dollars (\$3,000).

For the purpose of the transportation of discharged convicts, the sum of two thousand dollars (\$2,000).

For the purchase of new furniture, carpets, etc., for warden's house, the sum of five hundred dollars (\$500).

For the purchase of cook-range and tank, the sum of four hundred and fifty dollars (\$450).

For the purpose of steam heating for the penitentiary, the sum of six thousand dollars (\$6,000).

For the purpose of procuring books for library, the sum of three hundred dollars (\$300).

SEC. 2. The money hereby appropriated for the improvement of said penitentiary shall be expended under the direction of the warden, and in accordance with plans submitted to and approved by the executive council.

SEC. 3. This act, being deemed of immediate importance, shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the *Iowa State Register* and *Iowa State Journal*, newspapers published in Des Moines, Iowa.
