

A BILL

FOR AN ACT MAKING APPROPRIATIONS TO THE IOWA AGRICULTURAL COLLEGE.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa,* That there is
 2 hereby appropriated to the Iowa Agricultural College, out of any moneys in the treasury
 3 not otherwise appropriated, the sums for the purposes herein named, to-wit:

4 For a building to be used as an experimental kitchen, and its accompanying offices	\$5,000
5 For a building to be occupied by the schools in agriculture and veterinary science and 6 the botanical department	5,000
7 For buildings to be used as feeding barns by the professor of experimental farming	800
8 For swine-houses, corn-cribs and poultry-houses	1,200
9 For four boarding cottages, to meet the demand for additional room	6,000
10 For vault and fire-proof safe	1,500

11 For needed repairs upon college building and for necessary expenses incurred in the manage-
 12 ment of college lands, the sum of \$1,500 annually, the first payment to be made on May 1,
 13 1880, and the same sum annually thereafter: *provided,* that any sum remaining after the spe-
 14 cific object for which the same was appropriated shall have been completed may be used, so
 15 far as necessary, for any other of the purposes specified in this act.

SEC. 2. The board of trustees shall take vouchers in duplicate of all moneys expended
 2 under this appropriation, one of which shall be filed in the office of the auditor of state. The
 3 trustees shall, at the close of each month, present to the auditor of state a certified exhibit of
 4 all amounts due for labor done or material furnished during said month; and the auditor
 5 shall thereupon deliver to the treasurer of the college a warrant upon the state treasurer for
 6 the amount, and no warrant shall issue except upon such exhibit.

SEC. 3. This act being deemed of immediate importance, shall take effect from and after
 2 its publication in the *Iowa State Register* and the *Iowa State Leader*, newspapers published in
 3 Des Moines, Iowa.
