

A BILL

FOR AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO FURNISH BUILDINGS, BUY LANDS AND MAKE IMPROVEMENTS FOR THE SOLDIERS' ORPHANS' HOME AND HOME FOR INDIGENT CHILDREN, AT DAVENPORT, IOWA.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

SECTION 1. That there is hereby appropriated, for the Soldiers' Orphans' Home and Home for Indigent Children, at Davenport, Iowa, the following sums for the purposes designated, to-wit:

4 Four cottages, \$12,000.

5 School building, \$6,000.

6 Chapel and kindergarten, \$6,000.

7 Ice house, \$1,000

8 Industrial building, \$6,000.

9 Boiler and steam heating, \$5,000.

10 Water supply, \$5,000.

11 Electric lights, \$6,000.

12 General repairs, \$2,500

13 Land, \$1,350.

19 Industries, \$2,500.

20 Furniture, \$3,000.

21 Library, \$500.

22 Contingent fund, \$2,000.

23 Fencing and grading, \$1,000

24 Organs, \$400.

25 Nursery building, \$6,000.

26 The money hereby appropriated shall be drawn and paid on the order of the trustees of
27 said Home at such times as may by them be deemed necessary; *provided*, no more than one
28 half of this appropriation shall be drawn during the year 1886.

SEC. 2. This act being deemed of immediate importance shall take effect and be in force
2 from and after its publication in the Iowa State Register and the Davenport Daily Gazette,
3 newspapers in Des Moines, Iowa, and Davenport, Iowa.

A BILL

FOR AN ACT MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE IOWA SOLDIERS' ORPHANS' HOME AND HOME FOR INDIGENT CHILDREN AT DAVENPORT.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

SECTION 1. That there is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State treasury not otherwise appropriated, for the Iowa soldiers' orphans' home and home for indigent children at Davenport—

4	For ice house.....	\$ 300
5	For general repairs and contingent fund.....	2,500
6	For furniture to fit up hospital building as a nursery and dormitory....	500
7	For library.....	250
8	For organs.....	200
9	Total.....	\$ 3,750

SEC. 2. The money herein appropriated shall be drawn and paid on the order of the board of trustees of such home, at such times as may be deemed necessary by said board; *provided, however,* that not more than one-half of this appropriation shall be drawn during the year 1886, and the remainder quarterly during the year 1887.

SEC. 3. This act being deemed of immediate importance, shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the Iowa State Register and the Des Moines Leader, newspapers published at Des Moines, Iowa.
