

A BILL

FOR AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO PRESERVE THE WORK AND BUILDINGS BEGUN AT CLARINDA, FOR AN ADDITIONAL HOSPITAL FOR THE INSANE.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

SECTION 1. That there is hereby appropriated out of any funds in the State treasury to
2 protect the work done on the additional hospital for the insane at Clarinda, from loss or
3 damage, including the finishing of any portion thereof which it may be found necessary to
4 finish to be properly preserved, the sum of ten thousand dollars (\$10,000), or so much thereof
5 as may be found necessary.

SEC. 2. The money hereby appropriated shall be drawn and paid on the order of the
2 trustees of said hospital at such times as may by them be deemed necessary.

SEC. 3. This act being deemed of immediate importance shall take effect and be in force
2 from and after its publication in the Iowa State Register and the Des Moines Leader, news-
3 papers published at Des Moines, Iowa.

A BILL

FOR AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR THE CARRYING ON THE WORK AND CONSTRUCTION OF THE ADDITIONAL HOSPITAL FOR THE INSANE IN SOUTHWESTERN IOWA, AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa :

SECTION 1. That there be and is hereby appropriated out of the State Treasury of funds not otherwise appropriated, the sum of three hundred thousand dollars for the next biennial period, for the the purpose of carrying on the work and building of the additional hospital for the insane in Southwestern Iowa, located at Clarinda, as provided by chapter 201 of the acts of the Twentieth General Assembly.

SEC. 2. That the money thus appropriated shall be paid out and expended as provided by section 8, chapter 201 of acts of the Twentieth General Assembly, and as provided in said act.

SEC. 3. This act being deemed of immediate importance, shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the Iowa State Register and Iowa State Leader, newspapers published at Des Moines, Iowa.
