

A BILL

FOR AN ACT MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE COLLEGE FOR THE BLIND,
AT VINTON.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa :

SECTION 1. That there is hereby appropriated for the college for the blind, at Vinton, out
2 of any money not otherwise appropriated the following sums for the following purposes,
3 to-wit :

4 For removing slate roof and replacing new, thirty-three hundred dollars (\$3,300.)

5 New cornice on old building, hip ridges, conductors and coverings, thirty-four hun-
6 dred dollars (\$3,400).

7 Gutters, valleys and flushing, thirty-three hundred dollars (\$3,300).

8 Woodwork, repairs to porches and cupolas, two hundred and twenty-five dollars (\$225).

9 Painting outside and inside, twenty-one hundred dollars (\$2,100).

10 Repairing stone caps and mouldings, three hundred and fifty dollars (\$350).

11 Front steps between platform, brickwork, eight hundred and fifty dollars (\$850).

12 Portland cement work, six hundred and seventy-five dollars (\$675).

13 Iron stairs to replace wooden ones, worn out, thirty-one hundred dollars (\$3,100).

14 Taking out old floors, replacing with new, and leveling posts, seven hundred and
15 seventy-five dollars (\$775).

16 Repairs to inside wood work and plastering, three hundred and twenty-five dol-
17 lars (\$325).

18 For constructing two five hundred barrel cisterns, six hundred dollars (\$600).

19 For an additional boiler and necessary fixtures and front, eighteen hundred dol-
20 lars (\$1,800).

21 For contingent expenses and general repair fund, three thousand dollars (\$3,000).

22 For beds and bedding and furniture, two thousand dollars (\$2,000).

23 For additions to library and purchase to school apparatus, one thousand dol-
24 lars (\$1,000).

SEC. 2. The money herein appropriated shall be drawn and paid on the order of the the
2 trustees of said college at such times as may be deemed necessary by said trustees. *Provided,*
3 that any money remaining unexpended after the completion of the improvements for which

4 the sum is herein appropriated, may be used as far as necessary for any purpose specified in
5 this act; and, *provided further*, that not more than one-half of the amount herein appro-
6 priated shall be drawn during the year eighteen hundred and eighty-six (1886).

SEC. 3. This act being deemed of immediate importance shall take effect and be in force
2 from and after its publication in the Iowa State Register and the Iowa State Leader, news-
3 papers published at Des Moines, Iowa.
