

# A BILL

FOR AN ACT MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE INSTITUTION FOR FEEBLE-MINDED CHILDREN, AT GLENWOOD.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

SECTION 1. That there is hereby appropriated for the institution for feeble-minded children, the following sums, for the purposes mentioned :

3	For purchasing beds and bedding for use in cottages and old building.....	\$ 1,000
4	To be expended on central building.....	5,000
5	For repairs and contingent (annually, \$2,000).....	4,000
6	For new piano.....	400
7	For steam pump and changing old one.....	600
8	For library and surgical instruments.....	200
9		\$11,200

SEC. 2. The money herein appropriated shall be drawn as provided in this act, and paid upon the order of the trustees of said institution at such times as may be deemed necessary by said trustees ; *provided*, that not more than one-half of the bedding, contingent and library funds be drawn during the year 1886, and the remainder quarterly during the year 1887.

SEC. 3. This act being deemed of immediate importance, shall be in force from and after its publication in the Iowa State Register and the Des Moines Leader, newspapers published at Des Moines, Iowa.

# A BILL

FOR AN ACT MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE INSTITUTION FOR FEEBLE-MINDED CHILDREN.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa :*

SECTION 1. That there is hereby appropriated for the institution for Feeble-Minded Children the following sums for the purposes therein mentioned :

For purchasing seats, desks and other school apparatus six hundred dollars (\$600).

For broom shop and equipments, one thousand dollars (\$1,000).

For orchard and small fruit, one thousand dollars (\$1,000).

For purchasing bedsteads and bedding for use in cottages and old building, three thousand dollars (\$3,000).

For completing and furnishing central building, forty-one thousand five hundred dollars (\$41,500).

For two new boilers, engine and coal house, smoke stack and steam heating for central building, fourteen thousand five hundred dollars (\$14,500).

For improvement of grounds, one thousand dollars (\$1,000).

For purchase of 19 acres of ground, including all improvements belonging thereto, said ground being situated between last line of institution grounds and public highway, and now owned by H. Hanson, two thousand dollars (\$2,000).

For repairs and contingent fund annually, two thousand dollars (\$2,000).

For cisterns, one thousand two hundred dollars (\$1,200).

For a new piano and repairing old one, seven hundred dollars (\$700).

For library and surgical instruments, two hundred dollars (\$200).

For electric light, six thousand dollars (\$6,000).

For farming implements and carriage, four hundred dollars (\$400).

For steam pump and changing old one, six hundred dollars (\$600).

SEC. 2. The money herein appropriated shall be drawn as provided in this act and paid upon the order of the trustees of said institution at such times as may be deemed necessary by said trustees ; *providing*, that not more than one-half of the said appropriation shall be drawn during the year 1886.

SEC. 3. This act being deemed of immediate importance, shall be of force after its publication in the Iowa State Register and the Iowa State Leader, newspapers published in Des Moines, Iowa.
