

# A BILL

## FOR AN ACT TO APPORTION THE STATE INTO REPRESENTATIVE DISTRICTS AND DECLARING THE RATIO OF REPRESENTATION.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

SECTION 1. That one representative for every twenty thousand seven hundred and sixty-  
2 four inhabitants is hereby constituted the ratio of apportionment, and that each representa-  
3 tive district shall be as hereinafter described.

SEC. 2. Lee county shall be the first district and entitled to two representatives. (34,024).

SEC. 3. Des Moines county shall be the second district and entitled to two representa-  
2 tives. (35,733).

SEC. 4. Henry county shall be the third district and entitled to one representative.
