

A BILL

FOR AN ACT TO TRANSFER CERTAIN TERRITORY BY INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT OF PORTERVILLE, IN MARION COUNTY, TO INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT OF PLEASANT GROVE, IN MAHASKA COUNTY.

WHEREAS, Owing to the course of the Des Moines river and the contour of the adjoining
2 territory in Marion county, township 75, range 18 west, the board of directors of the inde-
3 pendent school district of Porterville, are unable to furnish school facilities for all the chil-
4 dren of the said school district ; and,

WHEREAS, By concurrent action the boards of directors of the independent school districts
2 of Porterville and Pleasant Grove are desirous to attach the east $\frac{1}{2}$ of the south-west quar-
3 ter of section thirty-six (36), section one (1), and so much of section twelve (12) as lies in
4 Lake Prairie township, in Marion county, to the independent school district of Pleasant
5 Grove, in Mahaska county, in township seventy-six (76), range seventeen (17), for school pur-
6 poses ; therefore,

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa :

SECTION 1. That the east half ($E\frac{1}{2}$) of the south-west quarter ($SW\frac{1}{4}$) of section thirty-six
2 (36), section one (1), and so much of section twelve (12) as lies in Lake Prairie township, in
3 Marion county, township 75, range 18, be and the same is hereby attached to independent
4 school district of Pleasant Grove, in Mahaska county, and made a part thereof for school
5 purposes.

SEC. 2. This act being deemed of immediate importance shall take effect and be in force
2 from and after its publication in the Iowa State Leader and the Iowa State Register, news-
3 papers published at Des Moines, Iowa.
