

A BILL

FOR AN ACT CONSTITUTING ADVISORY MEMBERS OF THE STATE BOARD FOR THE EQUALIZATION OF TAXES.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa :

SECTION 1. That the Governor by and with the advice of the Executive Council of this
2 State, shall, on the first Monday of January in each and every year appoint from each con-
3 gressional district of this State, one person who is a legal voter in such congressional dis-
4 trict, as an advisory member of the State board for the equalization of taxes.

SEC. 2. At the time fixed by law for the consideration of the equalization of taxes by the
2 State Board for such purpose, each of such advisory members shall be entitled to be present
3 at such sessions of such State Board of Equalization, and shall have the right to lay before
4 such board all such facts as such advisory members or either of them may deem necessary
5 to secure a just and equal assessment of the taxes to become due for such year : but no
6 advisory member shall have the right to vote in the proceedings in such board.

SEC. 3. The term of office of such advisory members of such board shall expire in one
2 year from the date of their appointment.

SEC. 4. Each of such advisory members of such State Board of Equalization shall be
2 entitled to receive as full compensation, to be paid out of the State treasury upon the order
3 of such board, the sum of five dollars per day for the time actually employed, and such
4 mileage in amount and per mile as is now allowed to members of the General Assembly.
