

# A BILL

FOR AN ACT MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE GIRLS' DEPARTMENT OF THE IOWA INDUSTRIAL SCHOOL AT MITCHELLVILLE.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

SECTION 1. That there is hereby appropriated out of the State Treasury not otherwise  
2 appropriated the following sums, for the purposes named:

3	For steam heating for new family building erected in 1885 .....	\$ 1,000
4	For contingent and repair fund .....	3,000
5	For purchase of eighty acres land .....	4,000
6	For school supplies .....	100
7	For completing water supply and grading .....	1,000
8	For bath tubs and plumbing .....	250
9	For furniture, beds and bedding .....	500
10	For Sunday suits for girls .....	500
11	Total amount appropriated by this bill .....	<u>\$10,350</u>

SEC. 2. The money herein appropriated shall be drawn and paid on the order of the  
2 board of trustees of said Industrial School at such times as may be deemed necessary by  
3 them; *Provided, however,* that not more than one-half of this appropriation shall be drawn  
4 during the year 1886, and the remainder quarterly during the year 1887,

SEC. 3. This act being deemed of immediate importance, shall take effect and be in force  
2 from and after its publication in the Iowa State Register and the Des Moines Leader, news-  
3 papers published at Des Moines, Iowa.

## A BILL

FOR AN ACT MAKING APPROPRIATION FOR THE GIRLS' DEPARTMENT OF  
THE IOWA INDUSTRIAL SCHOOL AT MITCHELLVILLE, IOWA.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

SECTION 1. That there is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State treasury not  
2 otherwise appropriated, for the girls' department of the Iowa Industrial School, the follow-  
3 ing sums for the purposes herein mentioned:

4 For steam-heating for new family building erected in 1885, the sum of (\$1,000) one  
5 thousand dollars.

6 For contingent fund, two thousand dollars (\$2,000).

7 For repair fund, two thousand dollars (\$2,000).

8 For new family building, heating and furnishing the same, thirteen thousand dollars  
9 (\$13,000).

10 For new roof, new floors etc., on and in main building, one thousand five hundred dol-  
11 lars (\$1,500).

12 For furniture fund, one thousand dollars (\$1,000).

13 For purchase of 80 acres of land, four thousand dollars (\$4,000).

14 For Library and school supplies, five hundred dollars, (\$500).

15 For organ, for new family building, one hundred dollars, (\$100).

16 For sewer and drainage, four hundred dollars (\$400).

17 For completing water supply, two thousand dollars, (\$2,000).

18 For laundry machinery, one thousand dollars (\$1,000).

19 For trees and small fruits, one hundred and fifty dollars (\$150).

20 For bath-tubs and plumbing, three hundred and fifty dollars (\$350).

21 For chaplain fund, for two years, five hundred dollars (\$500).

22 For salary for officers, for two years, ten thousand dollars (\$10,000).

SEC. 2. The money herein appropriated shall be drawn and paid on the order of the  
2 board of trustees of said industrial school at such times as may be deemed necessary by  
3 said board. *Provided*, that not more than one-half of this appropriation shall be drawn  
4 during the year 1886.

SEC. 3. This act being deemed of immediate importance, shall take effect and be in force  
2 from and after its publication in the Daily State Register and Daily Des Moines Leader,  
3 newspapers published in Des Moines, Iowa.
