

## A BILL

FOR AN ACT TO DIVIDE THE STATE INTO ELEVEN CONGRESSIONAL DISTRICTS.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa :*

SECTION 1. That this State shall be divided into eleven congressional districts as follows :

SEC. 2. First district—the counties of Lee, Van Buren, Des Moines, Henry, Jefferson,  
2 Louisa and Washington.

SEC. 3. Second district—the counties of Muscatine, Scott, Clinton, Jackson and Dubuque.

SEC. 4. Third district—the counties of Delaware, Buchanan, Black Hawk, Clayton,  
2 Grundy, Hardin, Bremer, Butler and Franklin.

SEC. 5. Fourth district—the counties of Fayette, Allamakee, Winneshiek, Chickasaw,  
2 Floyd, Cerro Gordo, Hancock, Kossuth, Winnebago, Worth, Mitchell and Howard.

SEC. 6. Fifth district—the counties of Cedar, Johnson, Jones, Linn, Benton, Tama and  
2 Marshall.

SEC. 7. Sixth district—the counties of Wapello, Monroe, Keokuk, Mahaska, Iowa, Powe-  
2 shiek and Jasper.

SEC. 8. Seventh district—the counties of Marion, Warren, Madison, Polk, Dallas, Guthrie  
2 and Audubon.

SEC. 9. Eighth district—the counties of Davis, Appanoose, Wayne, Decatur, Ringgold,  
2 Taylor, Lucas, Clarke, Union, Adams and Adair.

SEC. 10. Ninth district—the counties of Page, Fremont, Montgomery, Mills, Cass, Potta-  
2 wattamie, Shelby and Harrison.

SEC. 11. Tenth district—the counties of Story, Boone, Greene, Carroll, Hamilton, Webster,  
2 Calhoun, Sac, Pocahontas, Humboldt and Wright.

SEC. 12. Eleventh district—the counties of Crawford, Monona, Ida, Woodbury, Plymouth,  
2 Cherokee, Buena Vista, Palo Alto, Emmet, Dickinson, Osceola, Clay, O'Brien, Sioux and  
3 Lyon.
