

A BILL

FOR AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR A CONSTITUTIONAL CONVENTION ; PROVIDING
FOR THE SUBMISSION TO THE ELECTORS OF IOWA, OF THE QUESTION,
“ SHALL THERE BE A CONVENTION TO REVISE THE CONSTITUTION AND
AMEND THE SAME?”

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa :

SECTION 1. That when the Governor of the State shall issue his proclamation for the
2 election of State officers, for the general election of the year 1887, he shall also at said time
3 in such proclamation give notice to the qualified electors of the submission of the question,
4 “ Shall there be a convention to revise the constitution and amend the same?”

SEC. 2. At the general election in the year 1887, the question named in section one of this
2 act, shall be written on printed on each ballot, and at the end of said question the words
3 “ Yes,” or “ No” shall be written or printed on such ballot. All such ballots having thereon
4 the word “ yes” shall be counted in favor of the proposition so submitted, and all such
5 ballots having thereon the word “ no” shall be counted as against such proposition.

SEC. 3. The judges of election shall canvass the votes on such question at the same time
2 and in the same manner that they canvass the votes for State officers, and shall make return
3 thereof in the same manner.

SEC. 4. It shall be the duty of the county board of canvassers to canvass the vote on the
2 question submitted as aforesaid, at the same time and place they shall canvass the vote for
3 State officers, and shall make return thereof to the Secretary of State at the same time of
4 making returns for State officers in the year 1887.

SEC. 5. It shall be the duty of the State board of Commissioners at the time of making
2 the canvass of the vote for State officers, to canvass the returns of the vote so returned as
3 provided in section four of this act, and make a complete record thereof, and certify the
4 same to the General Assembly to be held next thereafter.
