[CONCURRENT RESOLUTION.

## CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

IN RELATION TO SOLDIERS' HOME.

*Resolved by the Senate, the House concurring:*

THAT the military committee of the Senate and the Soldiers' Home committee of the  
2 House, acting jointly and in such manner as in their judgment is deemed best, be and are  
3 hereby authorized to investigate the merits of the several localities that are or may be men-  
4 tioned as favorable locations for the proposed Home, with special reference to accessibil-  
5 ity, water and fuel supply, healthfulness, drainage, character and cost of land and building  
6 materials, etc., to report by bill or otherwise at as early a day as possible for the considera-  
7 tion of the General Assembly.

8 Adopted.

MR. FINN moved to amend by adding thereto, said committee to receive propositions and  
2 offers in writing from such persons as desire to offer advantages or inducements for the pro-  
3 curement of the location of said Home, and report the same in detail, said reports to be  
4 made within ten days from the adoption of this resolution.

BY HAMMOND—SUBSTITUTE TO SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION.

*Resolved,* That there be appointed by the Speaker of this House one from each congres-  
2 sional district in the State, and the same number from the Senate, whose duty shall be to  
3 select a location for the Soldiers' Home.
