## A BILL

FOR AN ACT, MAKING VOID ALL SALES OF HOUSEHOLD GOODS, WITHOUT  
CONCURRENCE OF BOTH HUSBAND AND WIFE.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

SECTION 1. Every sale, mortgage, or incumbrance of all, or any portion of the household  
2 goods of any married person, shall be invalid and void without the written concurrence of  
3 both husband and wife.

## A BILL

FOR AN ACT IN REGARD TO SELLING AND INCUMBERING HOUSEHOLD GOODS  
EXEMPT FROM EXECUTION.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa :*

SECTION 1. That no sale of or mortgage or incumbrance upon, all or any part of the house-  
2 hold goods, exempt from execution of the husband and wife, or of either, when living  
3 together and competent to contract, shall be valid without the written concurrence therein  
4 of both husband and wife, nor shall such sale, mortgage, or incumbrance of such property  
5 be valid in any case unless so concurred in by the husband or wife having at the time the  
6 immediate possession or control of said property ; but nothing in this act shall prevent  
7 either husband or wife from placing a valid lien upon such property as security for the pay-  
8 ment of the purchase price of the same, nor prohibit either from making a sale of, or mort-  
9 gage or other incumbrance upon such property to the other.
