[SENATE FILE No. 44.—APPROPRIATIONS.]

A BILL

FOR AN ACT MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR HOSPITAL FOR THE INSANE AT
MT. PLEASANT.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

SECTION 1. That there is hereby appropriated for the Hospital for the Insane at Mt.
2 Pleasant, out of any money not otherwise appropriated, the following sums for the follow-
3 ing purposes, to-wit:

4 For refrigerating building for cold storage, the sum of seven thousand dollars (\$7,000.)

5 For ice house the sum of three thousand dollars (\$3,000.)

6 For slaughter house and piggery, the sum of one thousand five hundred dollars
7 (\$1,500.)

8 For building for ironing, assorting, sewing and mending rooms, the sum of eight
9 thousand dollars (8,000.)

10 For repairs and contingent fund, the sum of six thousand dollars (\$6,000) per annum
11 for two years.

12 For improvement of grounds, the sum of two thousand dollars (\$2,000.)

SEC. 2. The money herein appropriated shall be drawn and paid on the order of the
2 Trustees of said Hospital at such times as may be deemed necessary by said Trustees: *pro-*
3 *vided*, that any money remaining unexpended after the completion of the improvement for
4 which the sum is herein appropriated may be used, as far as necessary, for any purpose
5 specified in this act; *and provided further*, that no more than one-half of the amounts
6 herein appropriated shall be drawn during the year 1886.

SEC. 3. This act, being deemed of immediate importance, shall take effect and be in force
2 from and after its publication in the Iowa State Register and the Iowa State Leader, news-
3 papers published at Des Moines, Iowa.
