FOR AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 4413, OF THE CODE OF IOWA, RELATING TO
PEREMPTORY CHALLENGES OF JURORS IN CRIMINAL CASES.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa :

SECTION 1. That section 4413, of the Code of Iowa, be, and the same is hereby amended
2 to read as follows:

3 Sec. 4413. If the offense charged in the indictment is or may be punishable with
4 death, the State and defendant are each entitled to ten peremptory challenges; if any
5 other felony to six each; and if a misdemeanor to three each.

A BILL

FOR AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 4413 OF THE CODE, RELATING TO PEREMP-
TORY CHALLENGES IN CRIMINAL CASES.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa :

SECTION 1. That section 4413 of the Code be so amended as to read as follows :

2 Sec. 4413. If the offense charged in the indictment is punishable by death or with
3 imprisonment in the penitentiary for life, or may be so punishable in the discretion of
4 the court, the State is entitled to six peremptory challenges and the defendant to
5 twelve ; if any other felony the State is entitled to four and the defendant to eight, and
6 if a misdemeanor, the State is entitled to two and the defendant to four challenges.

RELATING TO PEREMPTORY CHALLENGES OF JURORS IN CRIMINAL CASES.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

SECTION 1. That section 4413, of the Code of Iowa, be, and the same is hereby amended
2 to read as follows:

3 Sec. 4413. If the offense charged in the indictment is or may be punishable with
4 death, the State and defendant are each entitled to ten peremptory challenges; if any
5 other felony to six each; and if a misdemeanor to three each.

[SEC. 2. That section 4414 of the Code be, and the same is, hereby amended by striking out
2 the words "two jurors" in the third line, and inserting in lieu thereof the words "one
3 juror"; also, by striking out the words "two jurors" in the sixth line thereof, and inserting
4 instead the words "one juror."]
