## A BILL

FOR AN ACT TO REPEAL SECTION 2 OF CHAPTER 57 LAWS OF 1874 AND TO EN-  
ACT A SUBSTITUTE.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

SECTION 1. That Section two, of Chapter 57 of the laws of 1874 be and the same is hereby  
2 repealed.

SEC. 2. He shall monthly, at the close of each institute, transmit to the county treasurer,  
2 all moneys so received, including the State appropriation for institutes, to be designated  
3 the "institute fund," together with a report of the name of each person so contributing,  
4 and the amount. The board of supervisors may appropriate such additional sum, as may  
5 by them be deemed necessary for the further support of such institute. Said fund, shall be  
6 disbursed, by the county superintendent approving all bills, for services rendered, or ex-  
7 penses incurred in connection with the normal institute. Such bill to give the name of the  
8 parties rendering the service; and the amount due each one, the amount of, and for what  
9 purposes the expense was incurred, and to whom it is due; and thereupon said bill, or bills  
10 shall be filed with the county auditor, who shall draw warrants upon the county treasurer,  
11 payable to order of each particular claimant.
