A BILL

FOR AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO REIMBURSE EXPENSE INCURRED BY THE CAPTORS OF CERTAIN FUGITIVES FROM JUSTICE.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

SECTION 1. That the sum of eighteen hundred and sixty-nine dollars and forty-six cents
2 be and the same is hereby appropriated out of any funds in the treasury not otherwise
3 appropriated, to be paid T. J. Window and T. B. Crampton, of Waverly, Iowa, in reimburse-
4 ment to them of moneys expended in the detection, pursuit, capture and conviction of John
5 Cook and killing of his two brothers, Nicholas and Richard Cook, at Moberly, Missouri,
6 fugitives from justice, charged with larceny committed in Bremer county, Iowa.

SEC. 2. This act being deemed of immediate importance, shall take effect and be in force
2 on and after its publication in the Iowa State Register and Iowa State Leader, newspapers
3 published in the State of Iowa,
