A BILL

FOR AN ACT TO AMEND SECTIONS 1922 AND 1923 OF CODE OF 1873, IN RELATION TO MORTGAGES ON PERSONAL PROPERTY.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa :

SECTION 1. That section 1922 of the Code of 1873 be amended by adding thereto the following: “Within ten days from the execution thereof.”

SEC. 2. That section 1923 of the Code of 1873 be amended by adding thereto the following words, to-wit: “Within ten days after the execution thereof.”

A BILL

FOR AN ACT AMENDING SECTIONS 1922 AND 1923, OF THE CODE, IN RELATION
TO TRANSFERS OF PERSONAL PROPERTY.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

SECTION 1. Section 1922 of the Code is hereby amended by adding thereto the following
2 words: "Nor shall any such sale, contract, or lease be of any validity against any such
3 creditor or purchaser unless the same shall be filed for record within ten days from the date
4 thereof."

SEC. 2. Section 1923 of the Code is hereby amended by adding thereto the following
2 words: "Nor shall any such sale or mortgage be of any validity against any such creditor
3 or purchaser unless the same shall be filed for record within ten days from the date thereof."
