A BILL

FOR AN ACT ESTABLISHING THE SUPREME COURT AT THE SEAT OF GOVERNMENT, AND PROVIDING OFFICERS THEREFOR.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa :

SECTION 1. That the Supreme Court shall be held at the seat of government, and shall
2 convene and hold five terms each year, one of which shall commence on the second Tuesday
3 of January, one on the second Tuesday of March, one on the second Tuesday of May, one
4 on the second Tuesday of September, and one on the second Tuesday of November. Each
5 of said terms of court shall be for the submission and determination of causes and for
6 the transaction of such other business as shall properly come before the court. All causes
7 on the docket shall be heard at each term, unless continued or otherwise disposed of by
8 order of the court. The court shall remain in session until it is determined what the opin-
9 ion of the court shall be in all causes submitted to it, except in causes where a re-argu-
10 ment is ordered, and the consideration and determination shall be by the court. Judg-
11 ments of affirmance, rulings and orders in causes submitted, and orders authorized by law
12 may be made and entered by the court at any time regardless of the terms of court.

SEC. 2. The court is hereby authorized to appoint the necessary bailiffs to attend the
2 court and to perform such other duties and execute such orders as may be directed or
3 ordered by the court. Each bailiff shall receive two dollars and fifty cents for a days ser-
4 vice, to be paid out of the contingent fund on the order of the Chief Justice. The court
5 may also at any time require the attendance and services of the sheriff of Polk county.

SEC. 3. All causes and other business pending in said court for the terms now authorized
2 to be held at Council Bluffs, Davenport and Dubuque, shall be at once transferred for fur-
3 ther action and disposition to the term of said court which is to commence on the second
4 Tuesday of September, A. D. 1886.

SEC. 4. Sections numbered 133, 134, 135, 136 and 137, of the Code, and all acts and parts of
2 acts in conflict with this act, are hereby repealed.

 5 submission and determination of causes and for the transaction of such other busi-
 6 ness as shall properly come before the court. All causes on the docket shall be heard
 7 at each term, unless continued or otherwise disposed of by order of the court. The court
 8 shall remain in session so far as practicable until it is determined what the opinions
 9 of the court shall be in all causes submitted to it, except in cases where a re-argument is or-
 10 dered. Judgments of affirmance, rulings and orders in causes submitted, and orders
 11 authorized by law may be made and entered by the court at any time regardless of the terms
 12 of court.

SEC. 2. The court is hereby authorized to appoint the necessary bailiffs to attend the court
 2 and to perform such other duties and execute such orders as may be directed or ordered by
 3 the court. Each bailiff shall receive two dollars and fifty cents for a day's service, to be
 4 paid out of the contingent fund on the order of the chief justice. The court may also at
 5 any time require the attendance and services of the sheriff of Polk county.

SEC. 3. All causes and other business pending in said court for the terms now authorized
 2 to be held at Council Bluffs, Davenport and Dubuque shall be at once transferred for fur-
 3 ther action and disposition to the term of said court which is to commence on the first Tues-
 4 day of October, A. D. 1886.

SEC. 4. Sections numbered 133, 134, 135, 136, and 137 of the Code, and all acts and parts of
 2 acts in conflict with this act are hereby repealed.
