A BILL

FOR AN ACT TO REPEAL CHAPTER 162 OF THE ACTS OF THE TWENTIETH GENERAL ASSEMBLY AND TO ENACT A SUBSTITUTE THEREFOR.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa :

SECTION 1. That chapter 162 of the acts of the Twentieth General Assembly be and is
2 hereby repealed and the following enacted as a substitute therefor : That the board of
3 supervisors of any county in this State are hereby authorized to appropriate from the county
4 funds any sum not to exceed three thousand dollars, for the purpose of erecting on the court
5 house square or public park at the county seat or elsewhere in the county, as the Grand
6 Army posts in said county may direct it, a soldiers' monument or permanent memorial hall,
7 on which monument, or in which memorial hall shall be inscribed the names of all deceased
8 soldiers and all who may hereafter die, who enlisted or entered the service from the county
9 where such appropriation may be made, and also the names of such other deceased soldiers
10 as the Grand Army posts of said county shall direct.

SEC. 2. This act being deemed of immediate importance shall take effect and be in force
2 from and after its publication in the Iowa State Register and
3 newspapers published in the city of Des Moines, Iowa.

FOR AN ACT TO REPEAL CHAPTER 162 OF THE ACTS OF THE TWENTIETH GENERAL ASSEMBLY AND TO ENACT A SUBSTITUTE THEREFOR IN RELATION TO SOLDIERS' MONUMENTS.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

SECTION 1. That chapter 162 of the Twentieth General Assembly be and the same is hereby repealed and the following enacted as a substitute therefor: "That the board of supervisors of any county of this State is hereby authorized at the time of making the regular levy of taxes for State and county purposes to levy a tax of one mill on the dollar upon the taxable property of the county for monumental and memorial hall purposes; but such levy shall not be made more than twice in any one county; *provided*, that in counties of fourteen thousand inhabitants and less, one and one half mills may be levied not more than twice in any one county. All such taxes shall be levied and collected in the same manner as other county taxes; and when collected shall be used for the purpose of erecting at such place or places within the county as may be determined by the Grand Army posts of the county a monument or monuments or a monumental hall or halls, in honor of deceased Union soldiers, on or in which shall be inscribed the names with rank, company and regiment of all honorably discharged Union soldiers who enlisted from the county and who have died or may hereafter die, as well as the names of all such soldiers who enlisted from other counties or other States and have since died or may hereafter die and be buried in the county; and also the names of all other deceased soldiers, as the Grand Army posts may direct."
