

A BILL

FOR AN ACT TO AMEND CHAPTER 75, OF THE ACTS OF THE 18TH GENERAL ASSEMBLY, AND CHAPTER 137, OF THE ACTS OF THE 19TH GENERAL ASSEMBLY RELATING TO THE PRACTICE OF PHARMACY.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa :

SECTION 1. That section (3), chapter (75), of the acts of the 18th General Assembly, be and
 2 the same is hereby amended by striking out the words "without expense to the State," at
 3 the end of said section, and inserting in lieu thereof the words "the Secretary of State is
 4 authorized to furnish said commissioners with stationery and blanks necessary for their
 5 office."

SEC. 2. That section (8), of chapter (75), of the acts of the 18th General Assembly, be re-
 2 pealed and the following enacted in lieu thereof :

3 Section 8. Pharmacists whose certificates of registration are in full force and effect,
 4 shall have the right to keep and sell under such regulations as have been, or may be es-
 5 tablished from time to time by the Commissioners of Pharmacy, all medicines and pois-
 6 ons, provided that nothing herein contained shall be so construed as to shield the person
 7 who in any wise abuses this trust for the legitimate and actual necessities of medicine
 8 only, from the utmost rigors of the law, now or hereafter in force, relating to the sale
 9 of intoxicating liquors, and in addition thereto, for repeated violations, his name shall
 10 be stricken from the register by the Commissioners of Pharmacy upon receipt of tran-
 11 script of final conviction, which shall be transmitted by the court or by order of the
 12 court before whom conviction is had. Twenty-five per cent of all money recovered as
 13 fines under the provisions of this act, shall be paid into the State treasury and reported
 14 to the State Auditor, and held subject to the orders of the Commissioners of Pharmacy
 15 as needed to be by them used solely to defray the expenses of prosecutions and enforce-
 16 ment under the act or acts to which this is amendatory. County auditors shall at any
 17 time, upon written application therefor, issue to any pharmacist within their respective
 18 county, whose certificate of registration is in full force and effect, a permit to receive
 19 intoxicating liquors, and the presentation of said permit to any railway company, ex-
 20 press company or common carrier within the borders, or traversing the territory of the
 21 State, shall convey full authority to receive, transport and deliver intoxicating liquors
 22 to the person named in such permit. The Commissioners of Pharmacy shall on the re-

23 vocation or forfeiture of any certificate of registration subsequent to their last biennial
24 report or abstract of the State Pharmacy Register, report such revocation or forfeiture
25 to the county auditor of the county wherein such certificate was last in force.

SEC. 3. That section 2, of chapter 137, of the acts of the Nineteenth General Assembly, be
2 and the same is hereby amended by striking out the word "twenty-five" in the eighth line
3 and inserting in lieu thereof the words "not less than one hundred, nor more than two
4 hundred," and by striking out the word "one" in the ninth line of said section and insert-
5 ing in lieu thereof the word "two."

SEC. 4. This act being deemed of immediate importance shall take effect and be in force
2 from and after its publication in the Iowa State Register and the Des Moines Leader,
3 newspapers published at Des Moines, Iowa.
