

A BILL

FOR AN ACT TO APPORTION THE STATE INTO SENATORIAL DISTRICTS AND DECLARING THE RATIO OF REPRESENTATION.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa :

SECTION 1. That one senator for fifty thousand inhabitants is hereby constituted the
2 ratio of apportionment.

SEC. 2. Each Senatorial District shall be entitled to one senator, and every county and
2 district which shall have a number of inhabitants equal to one-half the ratio fixed in the
3 first section hereof, shall be entitled to one senator.

SEC. 3. Lee county shall be the first district, and entitled to one senator. (34,024).

SEC. 4. Van Buren and Davis counties shall be the second district, and entitled to one
2 senator. (31,353).

SEC. 5. Appanoose and Monroe counties shall be the third district, and entitled to one
2 senator. (29,265).

SEC. 6. Wayne and Decatur counties shall be the fourth district, and entitled to one sen-
2 ator. (30,577).

SEC. 7. Clarke and Union counties shall be the fifth district and entitled to one senator.
2 (27,871).

SEC. 8. Ringgold and Taylor counties shall be the sixth district, and entitled to one sen-
2 ator. (28,703).

SEC. 9. Page and Fremont counties shall be the seventh district, and entitled to one sen-
2 ator. (36,859).

SEC. 10. Mills and Montgomery counties shall be the eighth district, and entitled to one
2 senator. (29,628).

SEC. 11. Des Moines county shall be the ninth district, and entitled to one senator. (35,733).

SEC. 12. Jefferson and Henry counties shall be the tenth district, and entitled to one sen-
2 ator. (33,857).

SEC. 13. Washington and Louisa counties shall be the eleventh district, and entitled to
2 one senator. (30,434).

SEC. 14. Wapello county shall be the twelfth district, and entitled to one senator. (25,803).

SEC. 15. Iowa and Keokuk counties shall be the thirteenth district, and entitled to one
2 senator. (41,508).

SEC. 16. Mahaska county shall be the fourteenth district, and entitled to one senator.
2 (27,131).

SEC. 17. Lucas and Marion counties shall be the fifteenth district, and entitled to one
2 senator. (38,210).

SEC. 18. Warren and Madison counties shall be the sixteenth district, and entitled to one
2 senator. (34,103).

SEC. 19. Dallas, Guthrie and Audubon counties shall be the seventeenth district, and en-
2 titled to one senator. (47,314).

SEC. 20. Adams, Adair and Cass counties shall be the eighteenth district, and entitled to
2 one senator. (44,267).

SEC. 21. Pottawattamie county shall be the nineteenth district and entitled to one sena-
2 tor. (45,866).

SEC. 22. Johnson and Muscatine counties shall be the twentieth district and entitled to
2 one senator. (47,566).

SEC. 23. Scott county shall be the twenty-first district and entitled to one senator.
2 (41,956).

SEC. 24. Clinton and Jackson counties shall be the twenty-second district and entitled to
2 one senator. (61,500).

SEC. 25. Calhoun and Webster counties shall be the twenty-third district, and entitled to
2 one senator. (29,823).

SEC. 26. Jones and Cedar counties shall be the twenty-fourth district and entitled to one
2 senator. (37,486).

SEC. 27. Woodbury county shall be the twenty-fifth district and entitled to one senator.

SEC. 28. Linn county shall be the twenty-sixth district and entitled to one senator.

SEC. 29. Plymouth, Cherokee and Ida counties shall be the twenty-seventh district and
2 entitled to one senator. (37,077).

2 one senator. (31,330).

- 2 SEC. 45. Cerro Gordo, Franklin and Hancock counties shall be the forty-third district,
2 and entitled to one senator. (29,261).
- 2 SEC. 46. Floyd and Chickasaw counties shall be the forty-fourth district, and entitled to
2 one senator. (29,261).
- 2 SEC. 47. Tama and Poweshiek counties shall be the forty-fifth district, and entitled to
2 one senator. (39,825).
- 2 SEC. 48. Monona and Crawford counties shall be the forty-sixth district, and entitled to
2 one senator. (28,309).
- 2 SEC. 49. Kossuth, Emmet, Dickinson, Clay and Palo Alto counties shall be the forty-
2 seventh district, and entitled to one senator. (28,156).
- 2 SEC. 50. Carroll and Greene counties shall be the forty-eighth district, and entitled to one

- 2 SEC. 51. Osceola, Lyon, Sioux and O'Brien counties shall be the forty-ninth district, and
2 entitled to one senator. (30,423).
- 2 SEC. 52. Buena Vista, Pocahontas and Sac counties shall be the fiftieth district, and en-
2 titled to one senator. (30,423).
- 2 SEC. 53. The change of any district shall not effect any senator during the term of office
2 for which he has been elected.
