

## A BILL

FOR AN ACT TO APPORTION THE STATE INTO SENATORIAL DISTRICTS AND  
DECLARING THE RATIO OF REPRESENTATION.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa :*

SECTION 1. That one senator for every fifty-three thousand seven hundred and six inhabitants is hereby constituted the ratio of apportionment, and that each senatorial district shall be as hereinafter described.

SEC. 2. Lee county shall be the first district, and entitled to one senator. (34,024).

SEC. 3. Van Buren and Davis counties shall be the second district, and entitled to one senator. (31,353).

SEC. 4. Appanoose and Monroe counties shall be the third district, and entitled to one senator. (29,265).

SEC. 5. Wayne and Lucas counties shall be the fourth district, and entitled to one senator. (30,285).

SEC. 6. Clarke and Union counties shall be the fifth district, and entitled to one senator. (27,871).

SEC. 7. Ringgold and Decatur counties shall be the sixth district, and entitled to one senator. (27,813).

SEC. 8. Page and Fremont counties shall be the seventh district, and entitled to one senator. (36,859).

SEC. 9. Mills and Montgomery counties shall be the eighth district, and entitled to one senator. (29,628).

SEC. 10. Des Moines county shall be the ninth district, and entitled to one senator. (35,733).

SEC. 11. Jefferson and Wapello counties shall be the tenth district, and entitled to one senator. (41,798).

SEC. 12. Louisa and Henry counties shall be the eleventh district, and entitled to one senator. (9,788).

SEC. 13. Keokuk and Washington counties shall be the twelfth district, and entitled to one senator. (41,822).

SEC. 14. Mahaska county shall be the thirteenth district, and entitled to one senator. (27,131).

SEC. 15. Marion and Warren counties shall be the fourteenth district, and entitled to one  
2 senator. (41,287).

SEC. 16. Madison and Dallas counties shall be the fifteenth district, and entitled to one  
2 senator. (36,290).

SEC. 17. Taylor and Adams counties shall be the sixteenth district, and entitled to one  
2 senator. (28,119).

SEC. 18. Audubon and Guthrie counties shall be the seventeenth district, and entitled to  
2 one senator.

SEC. 19. Adair and Cass counties shall be the eighteenth district, and entitled to one  
2 senator. (32,121).

SEC. 20. Pottawattamie county shall be the nineteenth district, and entitled to one  
2 senator. (45,866).

SEC. 21. Muscatine and Cedar counties shall be the twentieth district, and entitled to  
2 one senator. (42,152).

SEC. 22. Scott county shall be the twenty-first district, and entitled to one senator.

SEC. 23. Clinton county shall be the twenty-second district, and entitled to one senator.

SEC. 26. Benton and Tama counties shall be the twenty-fifth district, and entitled to one  
senator. (45,524).

SEC. 27. Linn county shall be the twenty-sixth district, and entitled to one senator.

SEC. 28. Marshall and Story counties shall be the twenty-seventh district, and entitled to  
2 one senator. (42,563).

2 entitled to one senator. (35,162).

SEC. 39. Dubuque county shall be the thirty-eighth district, and entitled to one senator.

SEC. 41. Allamakee and Fayette counties shall be the fortieth district, and entitled to

2 entitled to one senator. (36,579).

2 one senator. (28,050).

2 entitled to one senator. (30,387).

SEC. 47. Clay, Buena Vista, Pocahontas and Palo Alto counties shall be the forty-sixth  
2 district, and entitled to one senator. (30,507).

SEC. 48. Plymouth and Cherokee counties shall be the forty-seventh district, and entitled

SEC. 49. Lyon, Sioux, Osceola, O'Brien and Dickinson counties shall be the forty-eighth  
2 district, and entitled to one senator. (29,188).
