## A BILL FOR

An Act to legalize and validate the proceedings authorizing and providing for the issuance, sale and delivery of County Memorial Hospital bonds by Adair County, Iowa, and the provisions made for taxes for the payment of said bonds and declaring said bonds issued pursuant to said proceedings to be enforceable obligations of said county.

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of Adair County, Iowa, did heretofore, by resolution authorize and provide for the issuance and delivery of County Memorial Hospital bonds of said county in the principal amount of one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) for the purpose of establishing, erecting and equipping a County Public Hospital and procuring a site therefor in said county and by said resolution provided for the payment of the interest on and principal of said bonds by the levy and collection of annual taxes on all of the taxable property in said county; and

WHEREAS doubts have arisen concerning the validity and legal sufficiency of said bonds and proceedings and the provisions made for payment of same, and it is deemed advisable to put said doubts and all others that might arise concerning same forever at rest.

*Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

- 1 Section 1. That all proceedings heretofore taken
- 2 by the Board of Supervisors of Adair County, Iowa,
- 3 authorizing and providing for the issuance, sale and

4 delivery of County Memorial Hospital bonds by Adair  
5 County, Iowa, and providing for the levy and collection  
6 of annual taxes to pay the interest on and principal  
7 of said bonds, are hereby legalized, validated, and  
8 confirmed and said County Memorial Hospital bonds  
9 issued, sold and delivered pursuant to and in accord-  
10 ance with said proceedings are hereby declared to be  
11 legal and to constitute valid and binding obligations  
12 of said county.

1     Sec. 2. This Act being deemed of immediate im-  
2 portance shall take effect and be in force from and  
3 after its publication in The Fontanelle Observer,  
4 a newspaper published in the City of Fontanelle,  
5 Iowa, and in the Adair County Free Press, a newspaper  
6 published in Greenfield, Iowa, all  
7 without expense to the State.

EXPLANATION OF H. F. 91

At the general election in November, 1945, Adair County voted a bond issue to finance the building of a Memorial Hospital. The notice of this election was published only 26 days before the date of election, whereas, the statute provides that it shall be published at least 28 days before the date of election. For this reason, a legalizing act is necessary in order to permit Adair County to issue bonds.
