A BILL FOR

An Act to amend section four hundred fifty-five and four tenths (455.4), code 1946, relating to boards of levee and drainage districts.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. Section four hundred fifty-five and four
2 tenths (455.4) is hereby amended by inserting after the word
3 "chapter" in line two (2) thereof the following: "and
4 Chapter four hundred fifty-seven (457)".

1 Sec. 2. Section four hundred fifty-five and four
2 tenths (455.4) is hereby amended by adding to said section
3 a new paragraph as follows, to-wit: "The term, or terms,
4 'engineer' or 'civil engineer' shall mean a civil engineer
5 as designated by Chapter one hundred fourteen (114), code
6 1946, or a registered professional drainage engineer or a
7 registered professional drainage surveyor."

1 Sec. 3. All laws, or parts of laws, in conflict here-
2 with to the extent of said conflict are hereby repealed.

1 Sec. 4. This Act, being deemed of immediate importance,
2 shall be in force and effect from and after its passage and
3 publication in the Upper Des Moines, a newspaper published

4 at Algona, Iowa, and The Bremer County Independent, a
5 newspaper published at Waverly, Iowa.

EXPLANATION OF H. F. 110

Due to the extreme shortage of civil engineers as designated by Chapter 114 of the 1946 Code of Iowa, it is necessary that many of the County Boards employ registered professional drainage engineers, or registered professional surveyors, to aid them.
