Compensation of Public Officers.

## A BILL FOR

An Act to amend section three hundred sixty-three point forty-three (363.43), Code 1946, relating to compensation of assessors and deputies, and to increase the number of full-time deputies.

*Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

1 Section 1. Amend subsection six (6) of section three  
2 hundred 'sixty-three point forty-three (363.43), Code 1946,  
3 by striking from line six (6) thereof the words "thirty-two  
4 hundred" and substituting in lieu thereof the words "five  
5 thousand"; by striking from line eight (8) the words  
6 "twenty-five" and substitute in lieu thereof the words  
7 "thirty-six"; by striking from line nine (9) the word "one"  
8 and substitute in lieu thereof the word "two"; by striking  
9 from line ten (10) the word "deputy" and substitute in lieu  
10 thereof the word "deputies"; by striking from line ten (10)  
11 the words "eighteen hundred" and substitute in lieu thereof  
12 the words "three thousand"; by inserting after the word  
13 "dollars" in line ten (10) the word "each"; by striking the  
14 period immediately after the word "annum" in line ten (10)  
15 and substitute therefor a comma (,), and insert immediately  
16 after said comma the words "and as many field deputies as

17 are required and necessary, said field deputies to be paid  
18 a compensation of eight dollars (\$8.00) per day for the time  
19 actually employed”.

1 Sec. 2. This Act being of immediate importance shall  
2 be in full force and effect from and after its publication  
3 in the Unionist and Public Forum, a newspaper published at  
4 Sioux City, Iowa, and in the Sioux City Journal-Tribune, a  
5 newspaper published at Sioux City, Iowa.

#### EXPLANATION OF H. F. 129

This bill seeks to increase the compensation of assessors and deputies in cities having a population of more than 60,000 and less than 125,000 and raising their compensations from the present limit of \$3200 to \$5000 for the assessors and from \$2500 to \$3600 for the two head deputies, and increasing the deputies from one to two and raising their salary from \$1800 to \$3000.
