A BILL FOR

An Act to make an emergency appropriation to the state board of education for salaries, support, and maintenance of the University Hospital, Iowa City, Iowa, the Bacteriological Laboratory, Iowa City, Iowa, the Iowa State Teachers College, Cedar Falls, Iowa, and the Iowa School for the Blind at Vinton, Iowa.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated out of any money
2 in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of
3 four hundred thirty-one thousand two hundred sixty dollars
4 (\$431,260.00) as an emergency appropriation, or as much thereof
5 as may be necessary, for the remainder of the fiscal year
6 1946-1947, to be used in the following manner and for the
7 following purposes, to wit:

8 MEDICAL AND SURGICAL TREATMENT OF INDIGENT
9 STATE UNIVERSITY HOSPITAL PERSONS,

10 1. For the purpose of carrying out the purpose of chapter
11 two hundred fifty-five (255), Code 1946, there is hereby
12 appropriated out of any money in the state treasury, not
13 otherwise appropriated, the sum of two hundred ninety-four
14 thousand dollars (\$294,000.00) as an emergency appropriation, or
15 as much thereof as may be necessary, to be used in the manner

16 and under the authority provided in said chapter for the
17 remainder of the fiscal year 1946-1947.

18 BACTERIOLOGICAL LABORATORY

19 2. For the Bacteriological Laboratory at Iowa City, Iowa,
20 for the remainder of the fiscal year 1946-1947, there is hereby
21 appropriated out of any money in the state treasury, not
22 otherwise appropriated, the sum of two thousand five hundred
23 sixty dollars (\$2,560.00) as an emergency appropriation, or as
24 much thereof as may be necessary, to be used in the manner and
25 under the authority provided in chapter two hundred sixty-three
26 (263), Code 1946.

27 IOWA STATE TEACHERS COLLEGE

28 3. For the salaries, support and maintenance of the Iowa
29 state teachers college, Cedar Falls, Iowa, there is hereby
30 appropriated out of any money in the state treasury, not
31 otherwise appropriated, the sum of one hundred thirty-one
32 thousand two hundred dollars (\$131,200.00) as an emergency
33 appropriation, or as much thereof as may be necessary, for the
34 remainder of the fiscal year 1946-1947.

35 IOWA SCHOOL FOR THE BLIND

36 4. For the salaries, support and maintenance of the Iowa
37 school for the blind, Vinton, Iowa, there is hereby appropriated
38 out of any money in the state treasury, not otherwise
39 appropriated, the sum of three thousand five hundred dollars
40 (\$3,500.00) as an emergency appropriation, or as much thereof
41 as may be necessary, for the remainder of the fiscal year

42 1946-1947.

43 Grand total of all appropriations for all purposes for the
 44 remainder of the fiscal year 1946-1947 for institutions under
 45 the state board of education.....\$431,260.00

1 Sec. 2. The appropriations provided for in this act shall
 2 be expended under the direction of the state board of education.

1 Sec. 3. The appropriations provided for in this act, shall
 2 be available on March 1, 1947, at any time thereafter, and shall
 3 be paid on the order of the state board of education.

1 Sec. 4. This act being deemed of immediate importance
 2 shall take effect from and after the publication in the

EXPLANATION OF H. F. 169.

The purpose of this bill is to make an emergency appropriation to the state board of education in order to meet the operating deficiency of approximately \$294,000 to the University hospital at Iowa City which is in prospect for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1947. It also provides for a deficiency appropriation in the amount of \$2,560 for the state bacteriological laboratory at Iowa City. It further provides for an emergency appropriation of \$131,200 for Iowa State Teachers College, Cedar Falls, Iowa, and \$3,500 for the Iowa School for the Blind at Vinton. These deficiencies are due to increased costs of living, salaries and wages, and maintenance.
