A BILL FOR

An Act to repeal certain sections, Code 1946, relating
 to authority of the state highway commission to
 stop motor vehicles and trailers for weighing
 and inspection.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. Sections three hundred twenty-one point
 2 four hundred seventy-six (321.476), three hundred twenty-
 3 one point four hundred seventy-seven (321.477), three
 4 hundred twenty-one point four hundred seventy-eight, (321.478),
 5 three hundred twenty-one point four hundred seventy-nine,
 6 (321.479), three hundred twenty-one point four hundred
 7 eighty (321.480), three hundred twenty-one point four hundred
 8 eighty-one (321.481), Code 1946, are hereby repealed.

EXPLANATION OF H. F. 198

This bill repeals six sections of the present Iowa Code which were inserted by the Forty-Ninth General Assembly. These sections gave the Iowa State Highway Commission authority to weigh and inspect motor vehicles and also to confer the authority of a police officer on certain of its employees. At the present time the Highway Commission is authorized to expend up to eighty-three thousand dollars per year to accomplish this purpose. Repeal of these sections will cancel this authorization and put the administration and enforcement of weighing and inspection back in the Department of Public Safety under Code Section 321.2, Code 1946.
