A BILL FOR

An Act to appropriate not to exceed the sum of fourteen thousand six hundred thirty-five dollars (\$14,635) for the purpose of paying the cost of grading and construction of paving of East Twenty-ninth Street between the right-of-way of the Chicago, Milwaukee and St. Paul and Pacific railway company and Eastern avenue in the city of Davenport, Iowa.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from the
2 State Treasury, out of any funds not otherwise appropriated,
3 the sum of fourteen thousand six hundred thirty-five dollars
4 (\$14,635) for the purpose of paying the cost of grading
5 and construction of paving of East Twenty-ninth Street
6 between the right-of-way of the Chicago, Milwaukee and
7 St. Paul and Pacific Railway company and Eastern avenue in
8 the city of Davenport, Iowa.

1 Sec. 2. This Act being deemed of immediate importance
2 shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage
3 and publication in The Daily Times and The Democrat
4 and Leader, newspapers published in the city of Davenport,
5 Iowa, such publication to be without expense to the State.

EXPLANATION OF H. F. 269

This is a bill to grade and pave a street now running through a portion of the Iowa Soldiers Orphans Home in Davenport. This paving would complete the paving of an existing street and will be of benefit to the Home in that the grade will be raised and will prevent the flooding of the playfield of the Home and by holding back Duck Creek which often has flash floods.
