A BILL FOR

An Act to repeal sections one hundred seventy-six point eight
 (176.8) and one hundred seventy-six point nine (176.9)
 Code 1946, relating to appropriations by boards of
 supervisors to farm aid associations and describing
 such associations.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

- 1 Section 1. Sections one hundred seventy-six point eight
- 2 (176.8) and one hundred seventy-six point nine (176.9) of the
- 3 Code 1946 are hereby repealed.

EXPLANATION OF H. F. 274

Section one hundred seventy-six point eight (176.8) requires that boards of super-
 visors appropriation sums range from two thousand dollars (\$2,000.00) to seven
 thousand dollars (\$7,000.00) per annum to subsidize to farm aid associations in the
 various counties. In view of the change of conditions since the enactment of this
 statute, it is believed that a subsidy is no longer needed and that it imposes an un-
 warranted drain upon the county treasurer.

Section one hundred seventy-six point nine (176.9) merely is a descriptive section
 which limits the operation of the previous section.
