A BILL FOR

An Act to amend chapter thirty-seven (37), Code 1946, relating to memorial halls and monuments for soldiers, sailors and marines.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. Section thirty-seven point two (37.2), Code
 2 1946, is hereby amended by striking the word "and" in line nine
 3 (9) of subsection one (1) of said section; further amend said
 4 subsection by inserting after the word "States," in line ten
 5 (10) thereof the following: "American Veteran's Committee
 6 and American Veterans of World War II (AmVets),".

1 Sec. 2. Section thirty-seven point ten (37.10), Code
 2 1946, is hereby amended by striking the word "and the" from
 3 line nine (9) thereof; further amend said section by inserting
 4 after the word "States," in line ten (10) thereof the following:
 5 "American Veteran's Committee and American Veterans of World
 6 War II (AmVets),".

1 Sec. 3. Section thirty-seven point twenty-two (37.22),
 2 Code 1946, is hereby amended by striking all after the word
 3 "acting" in line fifteen and inserting in lieu thereof the
 4 following: "veteran's posts and organizations composed of

5 members or former members of the armed forces of the United
6 States, in the county.”

1 Sec. 4. Section thirty-seven point twenty-three (37.23),
2 Code, 1946, is hereby amended by striking the words “American
3 Legion post” in lines three (3) and four (4) and inserting in
4 lieu thereof the words “veteran’s post or organization”.

EXPLANATION OF H. F. 310

The first section adds “American Veteran’s Committee and American Veterans of World War II (AmVets),”. Section two is the same as section one. Section three is amended by striking all after the word “acting” in line fifteen and inserting in lieu thereof the following: “veteran’s posts and organizations composed of members or former members of the armed forces of the United States, in the county.” Section four changes the words “American Legion Post” in lines three and four and inserts “veteran’s post or organization.”
