A BILL FOR

An Act to amend chapter two hundred fifty-eight (258), Code 1946, relating to vocational education.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. Amend section two hundred fifty-eight point
 2 one (258.1), Code 1946, line two (2), by changing the word “act”
 3 the word “the” to “acts”, and by inserting after the word “act” following
 4 in line eleven (11) the following: “and all other acts
 5 affecting vocational education up to and including Public Law
 6 586-79th Congress, Chapter 725-2nd Session, known as the
 7 “Vocational Education Act of 1946”, an act ‘to amend the act
 8 of June 8, 1936 relating to vocational education, so as to
 9 provide for the further development of vocational education in
 10 the several States and Territories.’ ”

1 Sec. 2. Amend section two hundred fifty-eight point seven
 2 (258.7), Code 1946, as follows:

3 1. Strike the word “three” in line five (5) and substitute
 4 in lieu thereof the words “one-third of the”.

5 2. Insert in line six (6) after the period (.) after the
 6 word “year”, the following sentence: “When first appointed
 7 the terms shall be for one, two and three years, respectively.”

8 3. Strike all of the sentence beginning with "The" in
9 line six (6) and continuing through the period (.) after the
10 word "work" in line twelve (12), and substitute in lieu thereof
11 the following sentence: "The committee shall consist of two (2)
12 public school educators, two (2) public school board members,
13 and one (1) lay member representing each of the service fields
14 of vocational education."

15 4. Strike all the words following the word "board" in
16 line thirteen (13) to the end of the section and substitute in
17 lieu thereof the following: "at such times as the board shall
18 deem advisable."

1 Sec. 3. Strike all of section two hundred fifty-eight
2 point eight (258.8), Code 1946, and substitute in lieu thereof the
3 following:
4 "Matching Provisions. The federal funds used in Iowa shall be
5 matched by state or local funds in accordance with the provisions
6 of the federal acts heretofore referred to."

EXPLANATION OF H. F. 341

This is non-controversial. The state has accepted the provisions of the Federal Vocational Education Act by an acceptance act, Chapter 258, Code 1946. Several amendments to the Federal Act have been passed which affect the operation of the state program. This act merely amends the state act to correspond with the changes in the Federal act.

It also provides for a change in the personnel of the vocational education advisory board to conform to the changing pattern of vocational education.
