A BILL FOR

An Act to amend chapter ninety-two (92), Code 1946, relating to the employment of persons under fourteen years of age.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. Chapter ninety-two (92), Code 1946, is
2 hereby amended by adding thereto the following: "No
3 persons under the age of sixteen years shall be employed,
4 permitted or suffered to work in any gainful occupation
5 during hours when school is regularly in session, and no
6 person under sixteen years of age shall in any event be
7 employed, permitted or suffered to work in or in connection
8 with any manufacturing or mechanical establishment or in
9 the erection, construction, repair or demolition of any
10 building or other structure or erection of any kind whatsoever;
11 provided, however, that children under the age of sixteen
12 years may be employed in agricultural pursuits during hours
13 when school is not in session."

1 Sec. 2. That all laws or parts of laws in conflict
2 herewith are hereby repealed.

EXPLANATION OF H. F. 363

This amendment to the law prohibits the employment of children under sixteen years of age in any gainful occupation during school hours and prohibits the employment of children at any time in any manufacturing or mechanical establishments or in the erection, construction or repair or demolition of any building or other structure or erection of any kind whatsoever.
