A BILL FOR

An Act relating to the prohibiting of hunting from aircraft without a permit, and providing penalties for violation of this act.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person to
2 intentionally kill, wound or attempt to kill or wound any
3 animal, fowl or fish from or with an aircraft in flight unless
4 such person shall have first obtained from the Iowa Aeronautics
5 Commission a permit to engage in such activity or pursuit.
6 Applications for such permits shall be made upon forms prescribed
7 by the Iowa Aeronautics Commission. No such permit shall be
8 issued to any person unless the Iowa Aeronautics Commission shall
9 find that such person is competent to engage in such activity or
10 pursuit with due regard to the property and safety of others. The
11 Iowa Aeronautics Commission is hereby empowered to adopt such
12 reasonable rules and regulations with respect to the application
13 for and issuance, duration and revocation of such permits as may
14 be necessary to carry out the purposes and intent of this section
15 and as may be required in the interest of safety.

1 Sec. 2. Any person who violates the provisions of this act

2 shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall
3 be punished accordingly.

1 Sec. 3. This act being deemed of immediate importance
2 shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and
3 publication in the _____, a newspaper published
4 at _____, Iowa, and in the _____,
5 a newspaper published at _____, Iowa.

EXPLANATION OF H. F. 378

This bill would prohibit hunting from aircraft except by those authorized to do so by the Aeronautics Commission upon proper showing of suitable competency.
